B) Environmental Consultancy Projects:

1) Maurya Enviro Project Private Limited – Balasinor Landfill for disposal of hazardous solid wastes

Project Status – Site construction completed upto a side slope depth of 4.5 m and retaining wall height of 3 m from GL in all respects. The site is under operation currently and the associate payment based on the expenses incurred has been made to GICEA by the Company. Capacity of the phase constructed from bottom of the site to GL is 91503 Cu.m. and that from GL to the top of the wall shall be 72354 Cu.m., thus totaling 1,63,857 Cu.m. Deducting the liners/ramp/leachate tank etc. volume of 12957 Cu.m., the Net capacity of the site shall be 1,50,900 Cu.m. and that in terms of weight basis shall be 196170 MT ~ 2 Lakh MT. Total Capacity of the phase at 9 m height of wall shall be 386465 MT. Total Amount of Consultancy received by GICEA from the project till date from the start of the project is Rs. 24,11,444/- (basic amount) (2% consultancy charges of basic cost) and Total



Cost of the project till date is approx.. Rs. 12.05 Crores. All forms of permits and licenses have been received by the company.

2) Hindustan Enviro Life Protection Services Limited – Khambhat Landfill for disposal of hazardous solid wastes

Project Status – Site construction completed upto a retaining wall clear height of 3.6 m from GL (total height of 5.40 m) in all respects. Capacity of the phase constructed from bottom of the site to total height of wall is 1,52,444 Cu.m. Deducting the liners/ramp/leachate tank etc. volume of 62334 Cu.m., the Net capacity of the site shall be 69,315 Cu.m. and that in terms of weight basis shall be 90110 MT. Total Capacity of the phase at 9 m height of wall shall be 417093 MT. Total Amount of Consultancy received by GICEA from the project till date from the start of the project is Rs. 22,89,522/- (basic amount) (1.75% consultancy charges of basic cost) and Total Cost of the project till date is Rs. 13.08 Crores. All forms of permits and licenses have been received by the company. The Company has also received a subsidy from State Government of 25% of the total project cost

3) Paramount Limited – HRRL Landfill at Rajasthan for disposal of hazardous solid wastes

Project Status – Submission of design drawings and calculations of each and every component of the landfill, including Process Design Basis, Process Description, Process Data Sheet, Unit Size Calculations, Utility and Chemical Consumption etc. was submitted to Paramount, which they have submitted to the Project main Consultant – EIL, New Delhi. EIL reviewed the documents, drawings and all the details submitted and gave corrections and queries which was fulfilled and submitted to them. A 3D model of the landfill was also prepared by Paramount and the said model was also discussed with EIL in January 2021 with online discussion. Acceptance of documents is awaited from EIL. Only after approval of the same the project construction shall start. Capacity of landfill to be constructed is 10,000 Cubic meters which shall last for 5 years. Total Consultancy Charges as per agreement made with Paramount is Rs. 10 Lakhs of which Rs. 3 Lakhs has been received from Paramount.

4) Rajkot Municipal Corporation – Sokhda Landfill Site:

Project Status – As such the construction of the project was over, however, due to problem of soil slipping on the side slopes, which happened during the last three monsoons, the project needs revamping. We have submitted a safe design for revamping and stability of the slope prepared by Setu Consultants. RMC has till now pressurized the contractor to complete the existing work remaining so that they can issue a Project completion Certificate. RMC is planning to float a new tender based on the design submitted by us. Because of the problem, payment from the project has not been received. Total estimated Consultancy charges is Approx. Rs. 17 Lakhs which as per last visit and discussion with the Exe. Engineer shall be paid to GICEA once the contractor gets his project completion certificate. We are expecting the same in 3 – 4 months now onwards.

5) Varni Enviro Care Pvt. Ltd, - Chotila Landfill for disposal of hazardous solid wastes

Project Status – We have submitted the landfill component of the project complete in all respect which includes design, drawings, estimate as per R&B BOQ and submission of tender for landfill construction. There were problems associated with the management of the company and hence as a result the company has paid only Rs. 3 L as advance. However, now the problems of the company's management is over and hence the project has now started and so payment from the company is now expected soon.

6) Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation – Landfill Phase 2 project at Gyaspur, Ahmedabad for disposal of municipal solid wastes

Project Status – We have completed the basic work of designing of the project and have submitted various options highlighting different capacity options as well as the approx. cost calculations associated of the landfill. It shall be finalized soon as AMC has formed a committee to finalize the same and once they approve the option, we shall start work on it and submit them the tender in short time after which we shall raise the bill for the project.

Thus, revenue generation from Consultancy Projects in the year 2021 – 2022 is Rs. 13,00,000/-, where as from testing is Rs. 8,74,350/-. Thus total revenue generation from the Environment Lab in the year was Rs. 21,74,350/-.

1 Method Accounting:

The Institute follows Accrual System of Accounting.

2 Revenue Recognition:

The membership fees and Subscription are accounted on receipt basis. However, the fees of subsequent years received in advance are shown as liability.

3 Life Membership fees and Entrance fees:

Life Membership fees and Entrance fees are credited to Trust Fund.



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4 Income from Earmarked Funds:

- (i) Interest earned on Investments of Earmarked funds are credited to respective Fund accounts
- (ii) The excess of expenditure over allocation of Interest to Earmarked Funds relating to Gold Medals, if any, is debited to Income & Expenditure account.

Balance as per last year

5 Fixed Assets and Depreciation:

(i) The Fixed assets are stated at their historical cost. (i.e the cost of their acquisition). In case of disposal/sale of asset, difference between carrying cost of asset and realization if any, is accounted for in Income & Expenditure account.

(ii) The Depreciation is provided on written down value method at the following rates:

- Building	10%
- Library Books	20%
- Furniture & Fixtures	10%
- Air Conditioners, Television, Projectors and Equipments	15%
- Computers	40%
- Vehicles	15%

6 Investments:

Long-term (Non Current) Investments are stated at cost. Dimunition in value of Investment other than temporary in nature, if any, are provided for in accounts.

7 Employee Benefits:

- (i) Contribution to Provident Fund and ESI are recognized as expense in Income & Expenditure account.
- (ii) Provision for Gratuity is made on actual basis.

(B) Notes on Accounts:

- During the year, the Institute has decided to celebrate completion of 75 years from its establishment by taking up various programmes and activities over FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23. For this purpose, it has received sponsorship and donations. During the year amount of Rs 1,31,46,000/- was received as sponsorship/donations. Out of this, amount of Rs 38,03,052/- was spent during the year which is adjusted against the amount of sponsorship/donations. The balance amount of Rs 93,42,,948/- to be spent in the FY 2022-23 is included under the head "Other Funds" in Schedule D
